

Vidyasagar Metropolitan College (formerly Vidyasagar Evening College) boasts a distinguished legacy shared with its sister institutions: Vidyasagar College and Vidyasagar College for Women. The origins of these institutions can be traced back to 1859 when Pandit Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar became the President of the Managing Committee of the Calcutta Training School. This pivotal role paved the way for the establishment of the Metropolitan Institution in 1860. The institution's growth led to its affiliation with Calcutta University for Arts on January 1st, 1872. In 1917, it was renamed Vidyasagar College, marking the beginning of a period of rapid expansion. The academic curriculum diversified with the formal establishment of the Commerce Department in 1922 and the introduction of the Morning Section for Women in 1931. Notably, the Commerce Department of the College holds the distinction of being the oldest in India, receiving its affiliation for the B. Com. Course under the University of Calcutta in 1928. Due to the rapid growth in faculty and student numbers, a separate wing dedicated to Commerce teaching in the evening shift was established in 1951. In 1961, this evening section became an independent entity with its own Governing Body, adopting the name Vidyasagar Evening College, and since then, the College has been committed to imparting knowledge to a diverse student body.

Over the past sixty years, Vidyasagar Metropolitan College has grown and evolved since its inception in 1961. The early years were marked by significant challenges, as the coeducational college shared a common building with Vidyasagar College and Vidyasagar College for Women, leading to space constraints that hindered the expansion of academic activities. However, with the recent construction of a separate building in 2014 and the modification of college working hours, the institution is now well-positioned to pursue its plans for expanding the academic curriculum.

The recent change in working hours necessitated the College's renaming from Vidyasagar Evening College to Vidyasagar Metropolitan College, with due approval from the University of Calcutta, the Higher Education Council, the Government of West Bengal, and the UGC. Today, in addition to Honours and General courses in Commerce, the College offers undergraduate programs in Humanities and Science subjects, with Honours available in Bengali, English, Political Science, Geography, Mathematics, Physics, and Physiology. Although the College's perspective plan is still unfolding, and challenges remain, progress is ongoing.

During the academic year 2021-22, Vidyasagar Metropolitan College offered various courses, including Constitutional Values, Communicative English, and a Certificate Course on Ecological Field Studies. Admissions and results showed varying levels of participation across programs, with notable achievements in Geography and B.Com Honours. The College organized diverse activities, such as environmental awareness programs, gender sensitization, and student seminars. Faculty members participated in numerous professional development programs and published significant research. Notably, Dr. Priyanka Khanduri received a best oral presentation award, and Ajijul Halder was recognized as the Student of the Year for Mathematics Honours.
