

Vidyasagar Metropolitan College (formerly Vidyasagar Evening College) shares a rich legacy with its sister institutions, Vidyasagar College and Vidyasagar College for Women. This legacy dates back to 1859 when Pandit Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar became President of the Managing Committee of the Calcutta Training School, which led to the establishment of the Metropolitan Institution in 1860. The College was affiliated with Calcutta University for Arts in 1872, and in 1917, it was renamed Vidyasagar College, marking a period of rapid growth. The Commerce Department, the oldest in India, was formally established in 1922, with the Morning Section for Women introduced in 1931. In response to growing faculty and student numbers, a separate evening wing for Commerce was created in 1951. This evening section became an independent entity in 1961, adopting the name Vidyasagar Evening College, and has since provided quality education to a diverse student body.

Over the past sixty years, Vidyasagar Metropolitan College has evolved significantly. Initially, the coeducational institution faced challenges due to shared space with its sister colleges, limiting academic expansion. However, with the construction of a new building in 2014 and adjustments to the College's working hours, it is now better equipped to expand its academic offerings. The change in working hours led to the renaming of the institution to Vidyasagar Metropolitan College, approved by the University of Calcutta, the Higher Education Council, the Government of West Bengal, and the UGC. Today, the College offers Honours and General courses in Commerce, as well as undergraduate programs in Humanities and Science, with Honours available in Bengali, English, Political Science, Geography, Mathematics, Physics, and Physiology. While challenges remain, the College continues to make progress towards its long-term goals.

The document outlines various academic, extracurricular, and collaborative activities at Vidyasagar Metropolitan College. Several courses were conducted, including Nutrition and Public Health Awareness, ICT and Computing Skills, and Mushroom Cultivation, among others. Admission and examination data reveal student performance across various programs, with significant admissions in B.Com Honours and B.A General courses.

The college organized numerous outreach programs through its NSS unit, such as Thalassemia Awareness, Blood Donation Camps, and Dengue Awareness Rallies. Faculty members participated in various professional development programs and published research papers in reputed journals, covering diverse topics from material science to environmental studies.

The college also engaged in collaborations with other institutions, including partnerships with several local colleges and national organizations for skill enhancement and capacity development. Key events included Independence Day celebrations, sports tournaments, and academic competitions. Awards and recognitions were also highlighted, including an outstanding paper award for Dr. Priyanka Khanduri and a D.Litt. degree for Dr. Sanjoy Pramanick.


