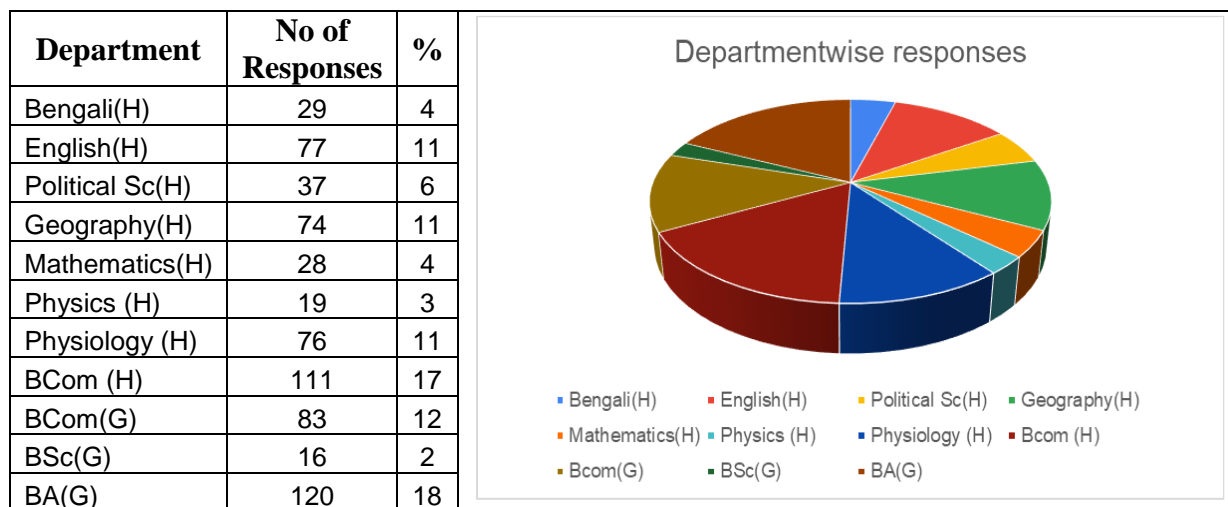
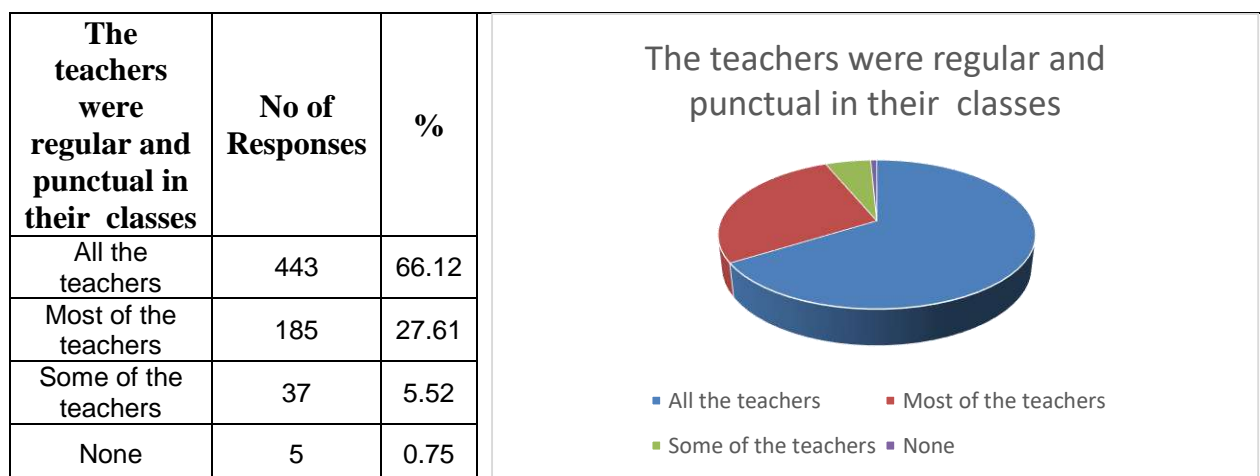


Students' feedback report and action taken

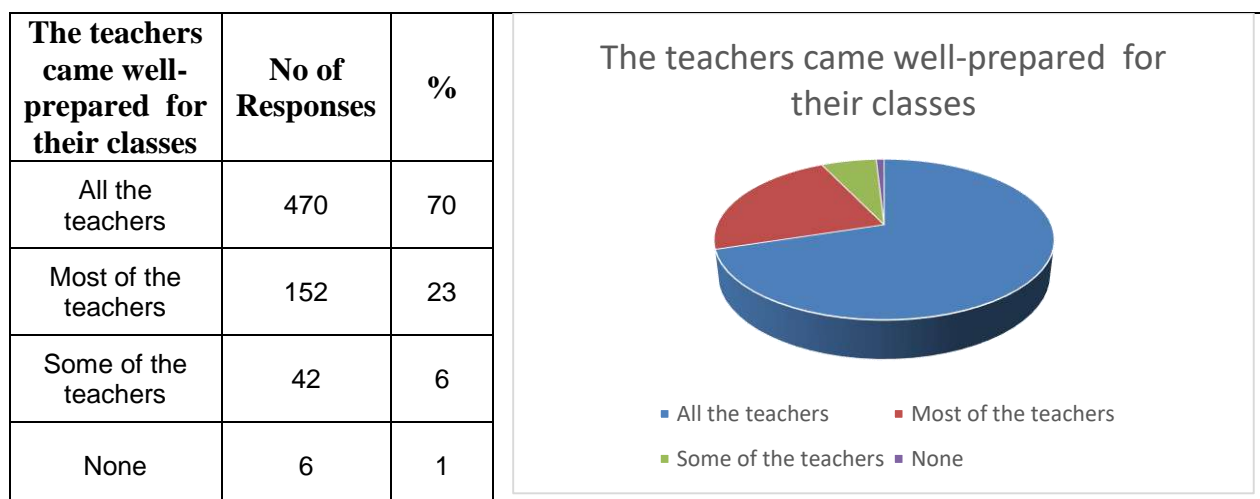
1. 670 students submitted their feedback regarding teaching-learning, college library, mentorship, co-curricular activities and college office.



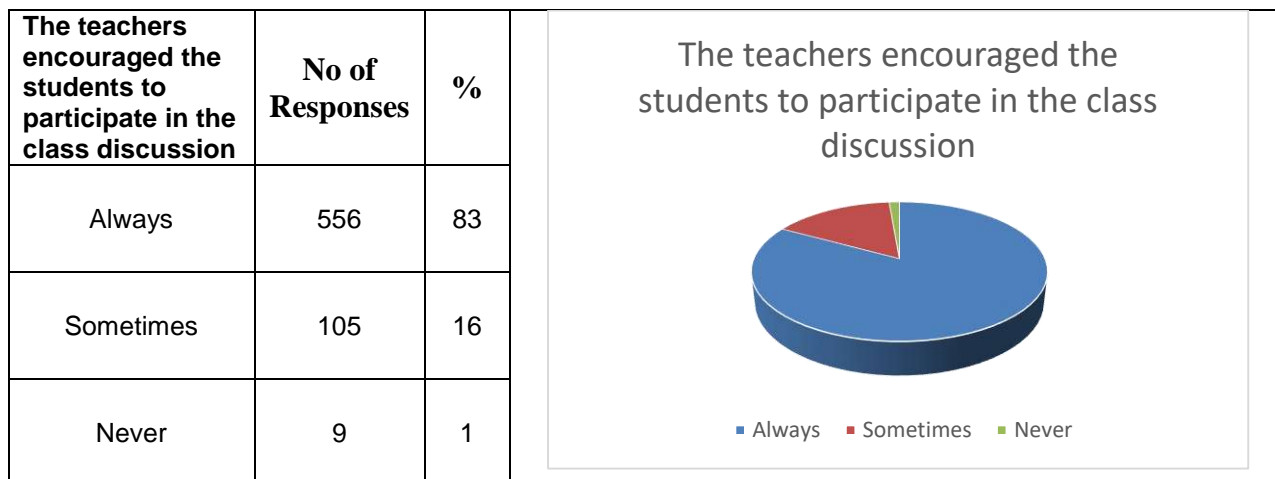
2. The students are of the opinion that most (nearly 95%) of the teachers maintain regularity and punctuality in attendance which proves the sincerity of the teachers.



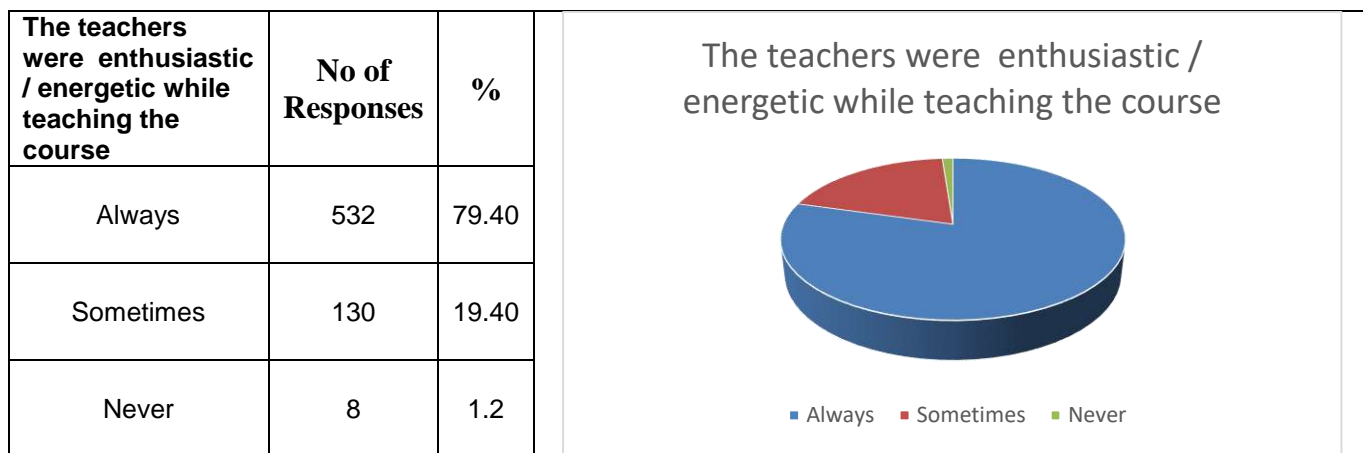
3. The students felt that 93% of the teachers come prepared for the classes and they were thus benefitted from their teaching.



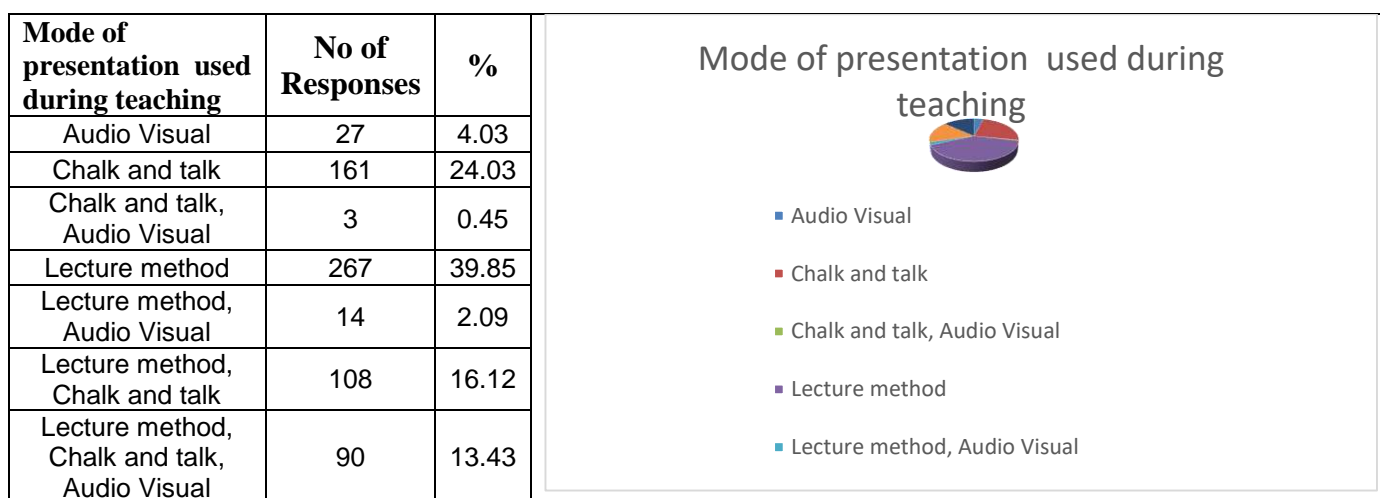
4. The students felt that an overwhelming 83% of the teachers encouraged the students to participate in the class which is an indication of the prudent nature of the faculty members.



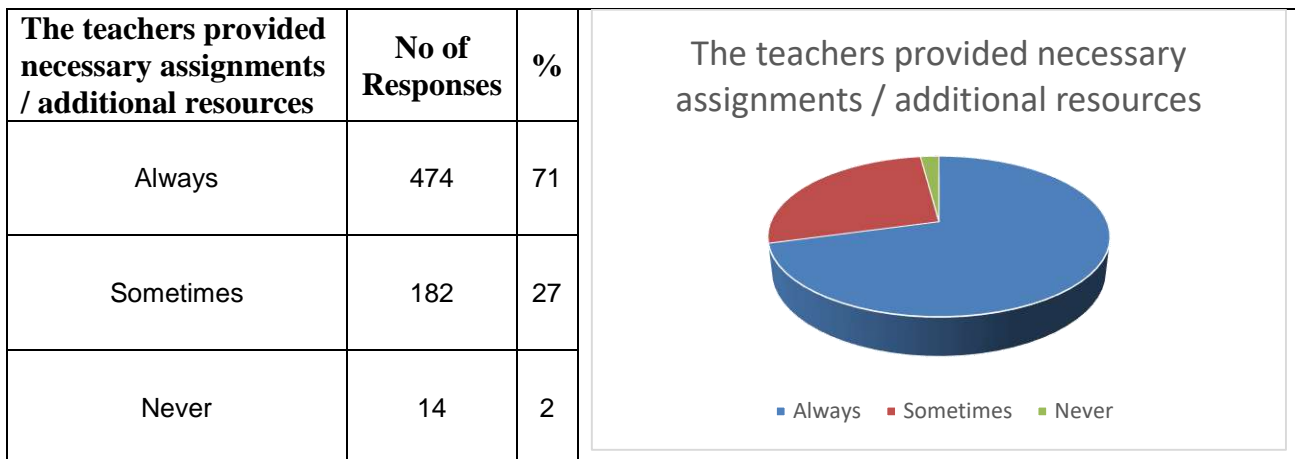
5. The students felt that almost all the teachers (close to 80%) taught with enthusiasm which benefitted them.



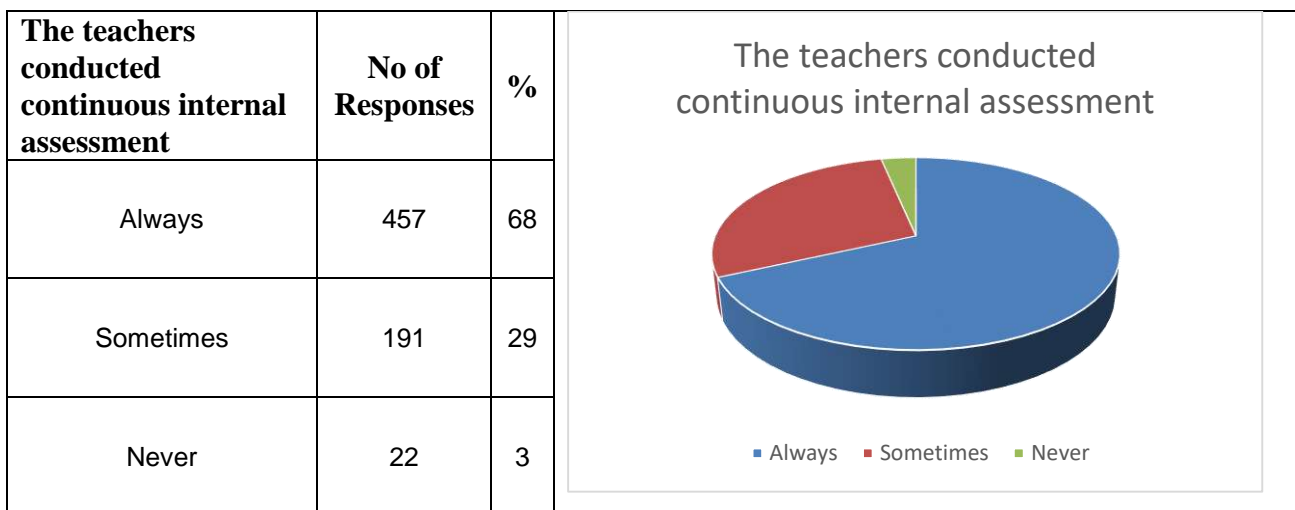
6. It has been opined that although majority (64%) of the teachers use lecture and chalk and talk method of teaching but some of them also use audio visual ways of delivering lectures.



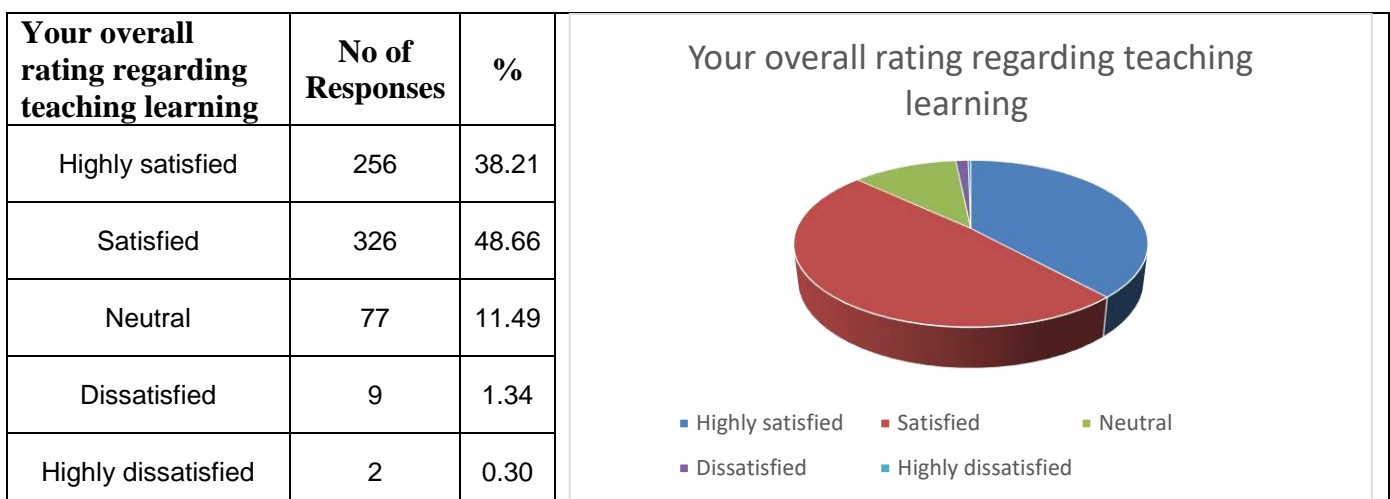

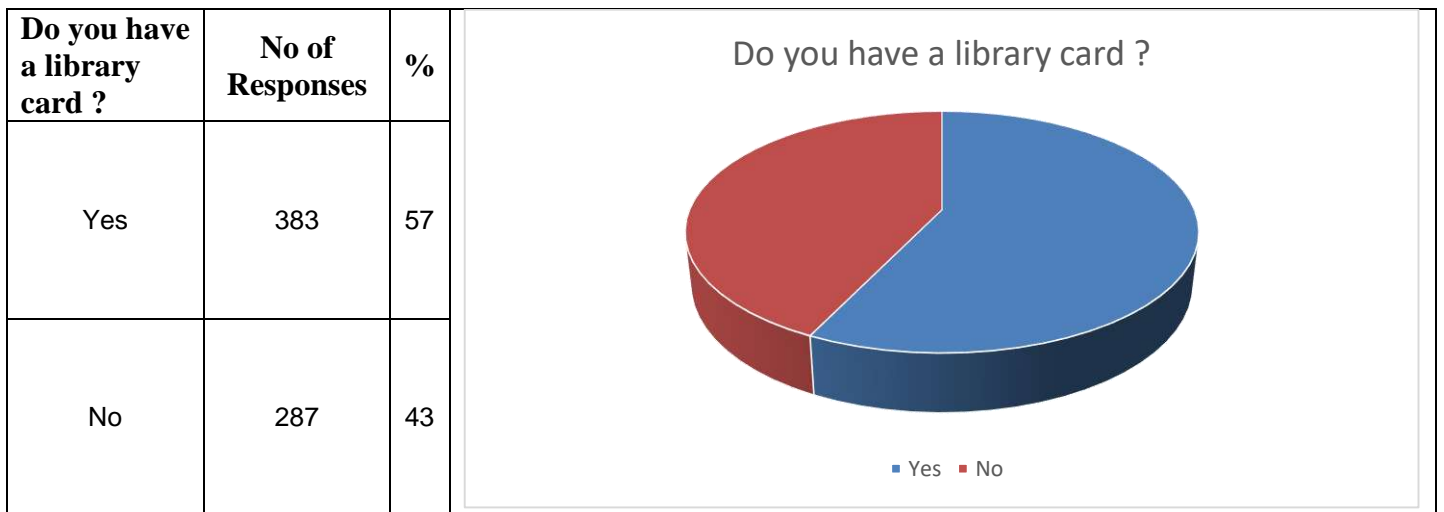
8. The feedback of the students prove that they are satisfied with continuous internal assessment conducted by most of the teachers which helped them prepare for their end semester examination.



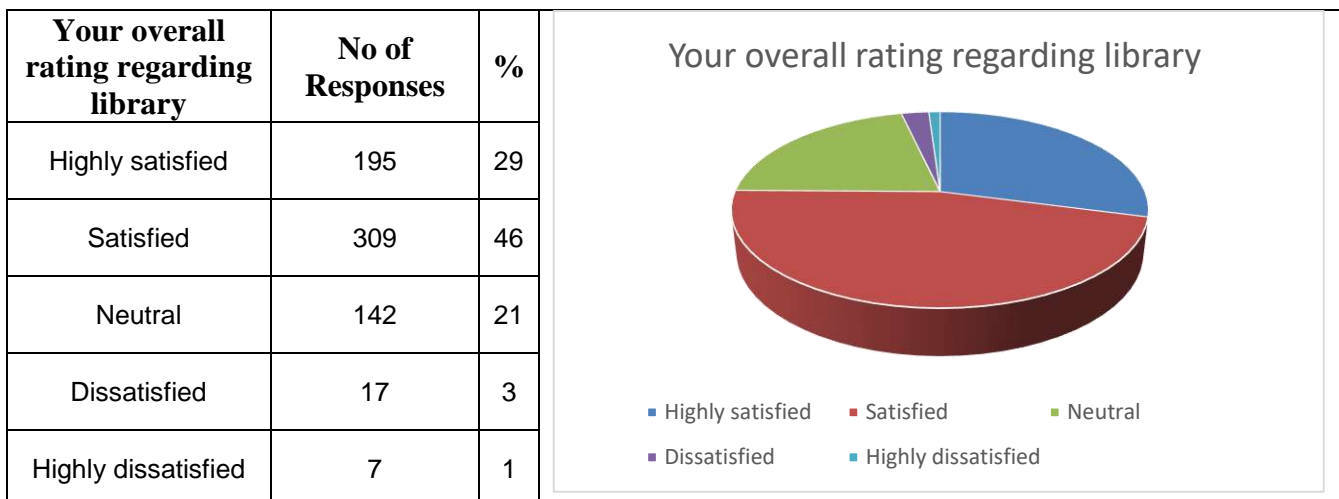
9. The feedback of the students show that 87% of the students are satisfied with the teaching learning of the institution.



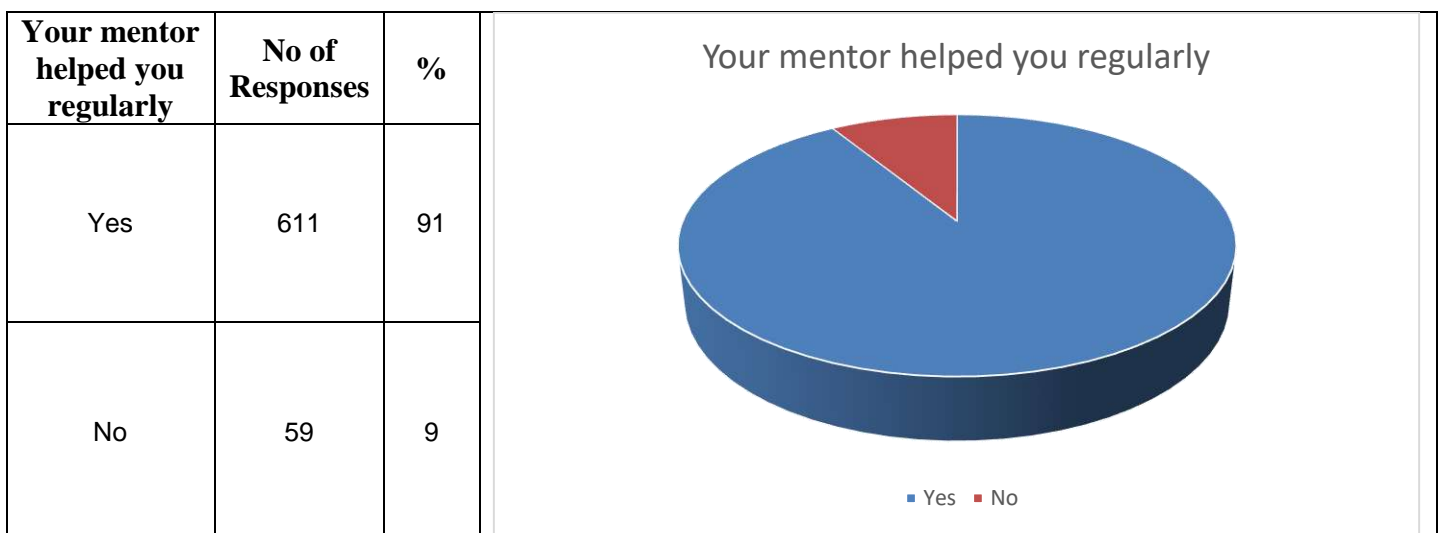
10. The chart below shows that 57% of the students have library card but it can be also be seen that 43% of the students do not have a library card which is a worrying factor.



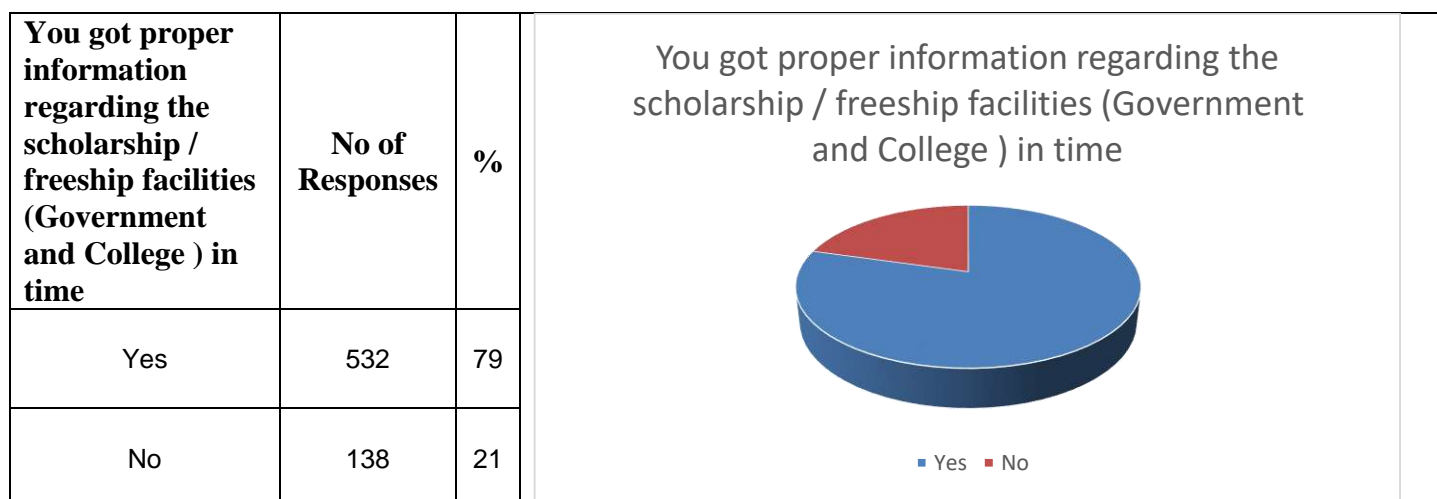
11. The overall rating regarding library has been found to be satisfactory.



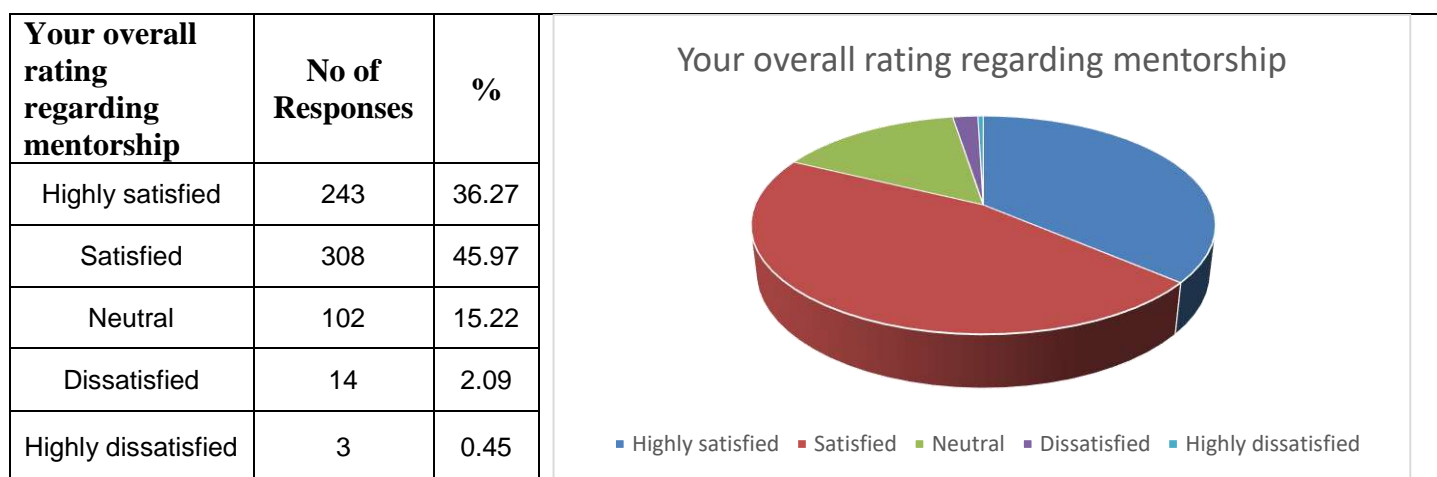
12. Majority (91%) of the students have opined that the mentors helped them regularly.



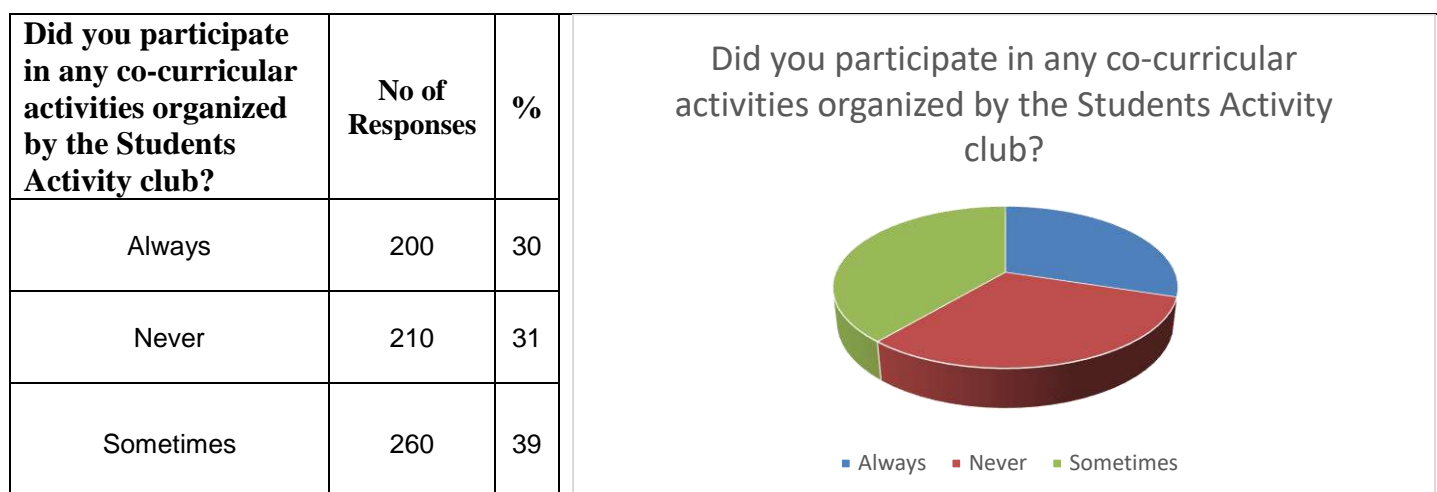
13. Almost 80% of the students feel that they got proper information regarding the scholarship/freeships from their mentors which shows that the mentors are aware of their role.



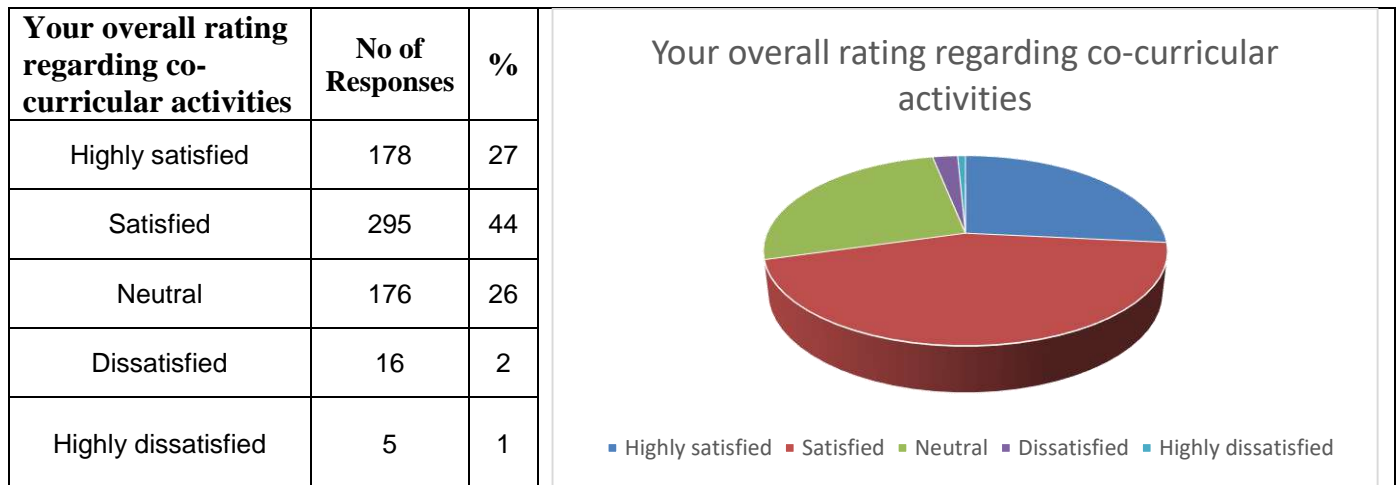
14. The students are more than satisfied with mentors of the institution.



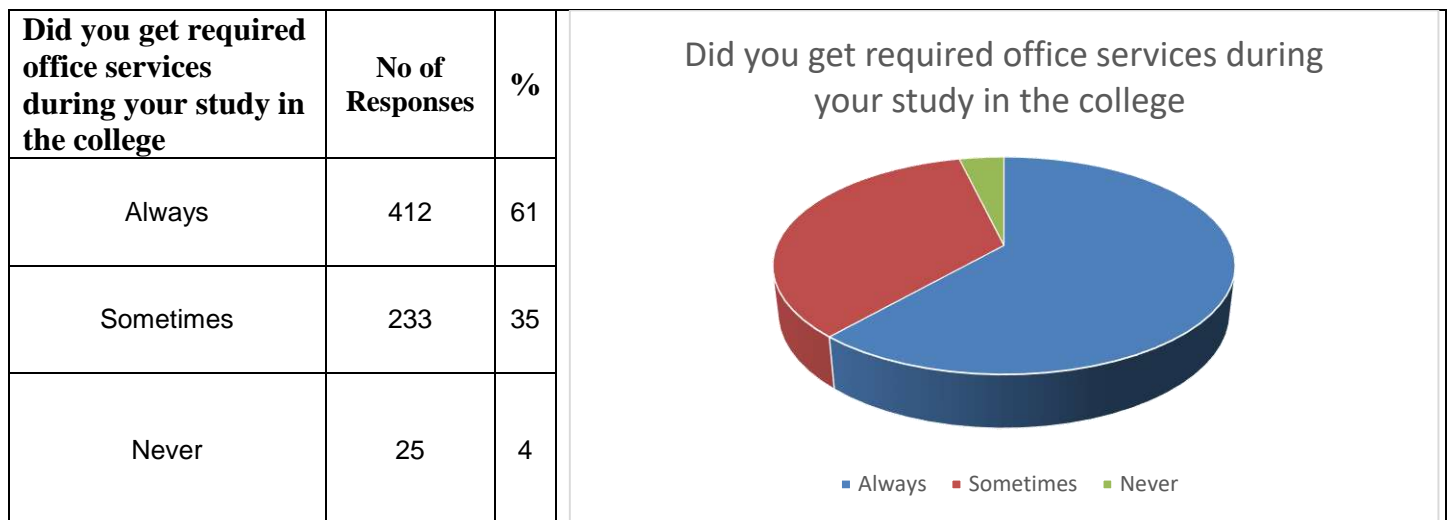
15. It can be seen that almost 70% of the students have participated in the co-curricular activities organized by the Students' Activity Club which goes to show that teacher-student association in the college.



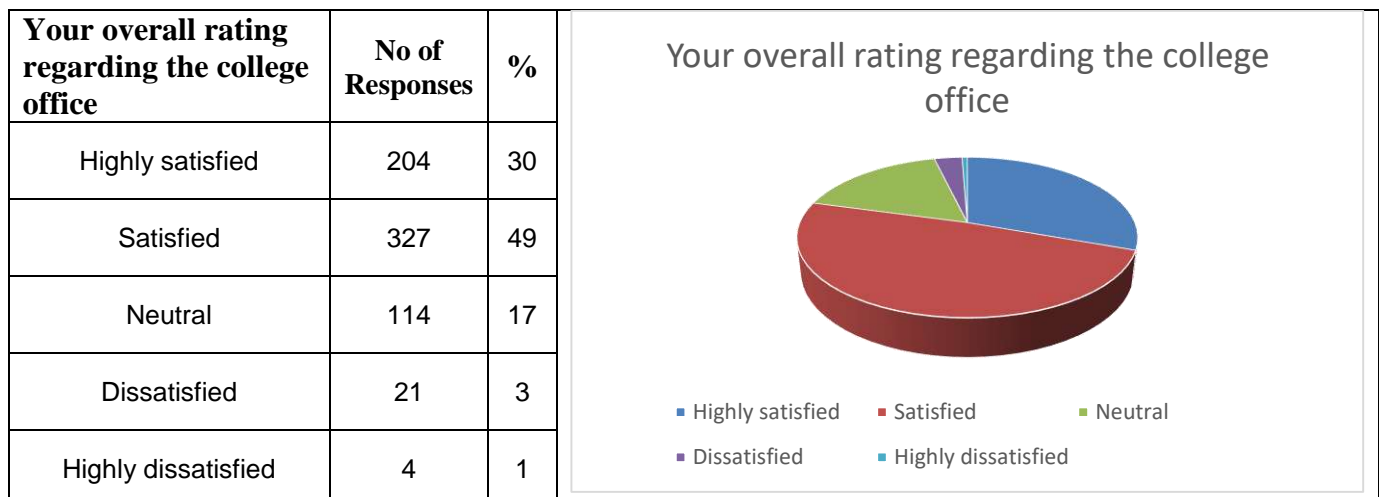
16. The chart below reveals that more than 50% of the students are satisfied with the co-curricular activities of the institution.



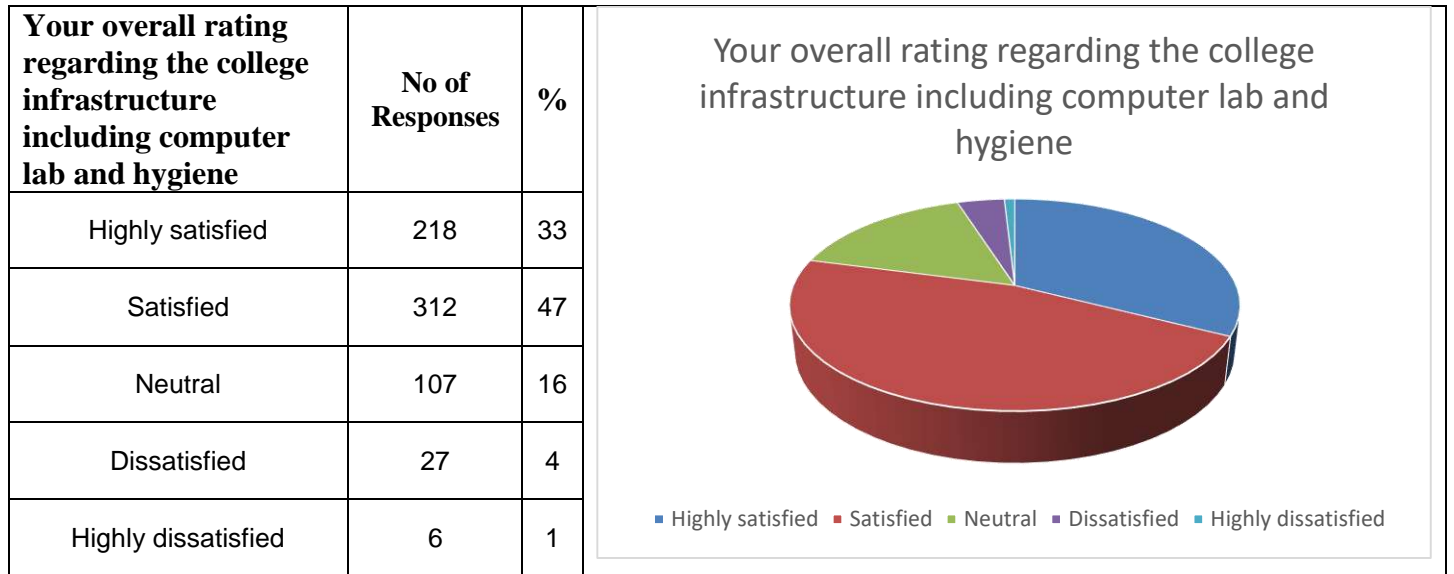
17. The students' feedback regarding the office of the college seems satisfactory as in 96% of the cases the students have received positive responses.



18. The chart below further proves that the students are satisfied with the performance of the college office.

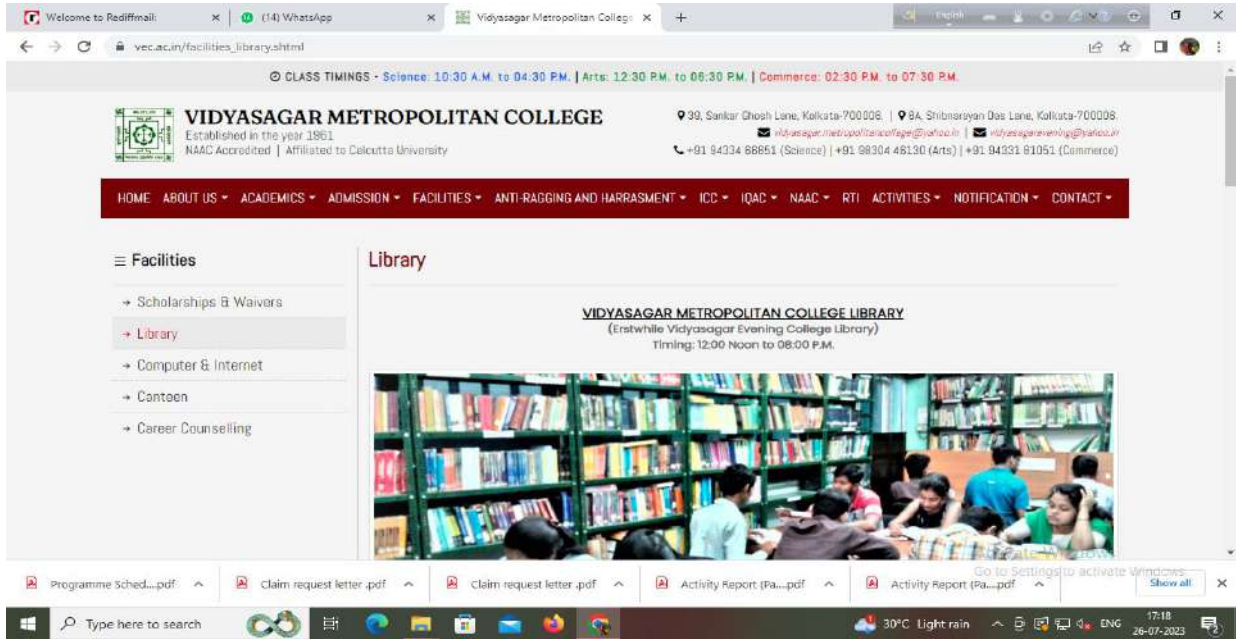


19. 80% of the students are satisfied with the infrastructural facilities of the college although there is scope for improvement.
